
Swipe through to learn about arts districts in cities around the country.










Seattle is home to several art districts. The Capitol Hill Arts District is home to more than 40 arts and cultural organizations, and the Historic Central Area Arts & Cultural District celebrates the city's African-American heritage and history. Also don't miss the Uptown Arts and Cultural District.



The Northeast Minneapolis Arts District is home to hundreds of local artists, whose work is featured in studios and galleries located in old warehouses that have been updated. Visitors find plenty of shopping and dining, as well.
